Course Description:

In the MyPath course, students will propose a personalized plan of study focused on post-secondary interests and goals. Students will work with an instructor to collaboratively create a project management plan. Within this plan, the student will identify topics to be covered, curricular standards to be met, learning goals, activities, and a timeline. Students will create periodic presentations on their learning and progress, culminating in a capstone presentation to a public audience.

Course Rationale:

MyPath develops students independence, personal motivation, organization, and communication skills in a unique format, in which student academic and/or post-secondary interests drive the course.

Course Objectives:

The student will research their chosen topic to create a detailed project management plan, including course goals, a timeline, and outcomes (A+ Research)

The student will share performance activities, reflections and learning through their chosen topic in an oral presentation and then listen and respond to feedback provided. (A+ Speaking and Listening)

The student will select appropriate text to read extensively and reflect on topics associated with detailed project management plan. (A+ Reading)

The student will submit written activity logs and reflection journals on a regular basis. (A+ Writing)
