Independent Study - English Language Arts

Rationale

This course is designed to provide an opportunity for the upper level English Language Arts student to explore a specific topic of his/her choice, emphasizing work ethic, deadlines, and research.

Course Description

This course is designed for the student possessing a high degree of independence and responsibility, and who desires to investigate topics not available through regular course work. The course objectives, outline, and evaluation procedures must be developed by the student and teacher and submitted to the department chairperson prior to enrollment.
