This course promotes knowledge of child development, consumer skills, foods and nutrition, and the production of clothing and textiles through hands-on projects and real world applications. Students will complete a beginning level sewing project, develop food safety and nutrition skills, as well familiarity with basic child development.

Introduction to Family and Consumer Sciences is a semester course designed for the middle school 6- 8th grade student. The course provides the opportunity to explore real-world applications of Family and Consumer Sciences. The program develops transferable skills for home, workplace, community and global society.
