Rationale

The purpose of providing art in an introductory setting is to develop an understanding and appreciation of art as well as make connections to their lives and the world around them. The student will be introduced to the progress of art through time via the study of various cultures, periods, themes, and processes. They will work toward mastery of understanding and use of elements of art and principles of design.

Course Description

The student in Introduction to Art will explore painting, sculpting, printmaking, drawing, design, mixed-media, and ceramics (clay).
